## **Current Situation (Civil Works)**

- FY09 – Allotments not yet received
- ARRA – Project list not yet approved
- FY10 – Being prepared – expect President's Budget in early May



## **\$4.6B in ARRA Projects for USACE (CW)**

- **Criteria:**
  - Earliest contract awards (O&M)
  - Construction – early phase or project completion
  - Put people to work quickly (shovel ready)
  - Little chance of slippage (low risk)
  - No environmental or other issues
  - Economic benefits
  - Sponsor must have cost share if applicable



# **\$4.6B in ARRA Projects for USACE (CW) (2)**

- Allocation of Stimulus Funds
  - Balanced across the nation (intent)
  - Projects with earliest start date funded first
  - Project that don't execute will have funds reallocated to next ready project



## \$4.6B in ARRA Projects for USACE (3)

- How will the funds be spent:
  - IFB and RFP
  - IDIQs, MATOCs, POCAs (old and new)
  - 8A Set Aside and Small Business
  - Increase existing contracts
  - Internal hiring (temp and perm)

## **Military and IIS Projects for USACE**

- **Military Construction (MILCON)**
  - USACE received \$1.5B
  - SPD will receive in the area of \$100M
- **Military O & M**
  - SPD will receive in the area of \$150M
- **Interagency and International Support**
  - Regular partners: VA, DOE, DHS/CBP/ICE, EPA, etc
  - Work coming to SPD only partially known

- **Reporting Requirements:**
  - Absolute transparency
  - Weekly postings on recovery web site
  - Measure progress in jobs and project/phase completions
