The need to consider cumulative regulatory impacts on the Bay Area's regional job growth and economic competitiveness

The purpose of the cumulative impact analysis is to avoid considering ~~projects~~ **regulations** in a vacuum, because failure to consider cumulative harm may risk ~~environmental~~ **economic** disaster. Without this analysis, piecemeal approval of several ~~projects~~ **regulations** with related impacts could lead to severe ~~environmental~~ **economic** harm. An adequate analysis of cumulative impacts is particularly important when another related ~~project~~ **regulation** might significantly worsen the ~~project's~~ **regulation's** adverse ~~environmental~~ **economic** impacts. The requirement of a cumulative impacts analysis of a ~~project's~~ **regulation's** regional impacts has been described as a 'vital provision' of ~~CEQA~~ _____.
